PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

The purpose of this report is to present the submissions received in response to the proposal to restrict vehicles from specific areas of the district, and for Council to hear oral submissions from those who indicated they would like to be heard.

BACKGROUND

Council sought public feedback (from 4 May 2010 to 4 June 2010) on a proposal to restrict vehicles weighing under 3500kg from specific areas within the District.

The proposal sought to restrict vehicles between the hours of 10pm and 5am daily unless the driver is able to show there is a legitimate purpose for being in that location.

The areas proposed for restriction were:

- Takanini Business Area – being Spartan Road, part of Oakleigh Ave, Westbrook Ave, Rawson Way, Rangi Road, Heb Place, Marphona Crescent and part of Takanini School Road.
- Drury Industrial Area – being part of Norrie Road, Firth Street and Creek Street.
- Hunua Industrial Area – being part of Boundary Road, Parker Street, Croskery Road, Markedo Place, Berlane Place, Margaret Williams Drive, part of Dominion Road, and Dent Place.
- Gatland Road
- Unsealed section at the end of Old Wairoa Road

Notification of the proposal occurred through a mail out to all residents/businesses on the roads proposed for restriction, public notice, and inclusion on Papakura District Council’s website.

NARRATIVE

The proposal attracted 65 written submissions. Of these, 8 expressed a wish to be heard by Council. This Council meeting provides opportunity for these submitters to support their views further via oral submission.

Deliberations on all submissions (both written and oral) will be undertaken at the next Council meeting on 27 July 2010.

CONCLUSION

Council recently sought public feedback on a proposal to restrict vehicles from specific areas of the District. Eight submitters expressed a wish to present an oral submission to Council. These will be heard today, with deliberations taking place at the next full Council meeting.

PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

The purpose of this report is to present the submissions received relating to the proposal to change the name of the Hawkins Theatre and for Council to hear oral submissions from those who indicated they would like to be heard.

BACKGROUND

Council sought public feedback (from 18 May 2010 to 18 June 2010) on a proposal to change the name of the Hawkins Theatre

Council asked whether the Hawkins Theatre name should be changed and if so asked for preference to be indicated in relation to three alternative names; being:

- Arthouse Papakura
- Papakura Arts Theatre
- The Arts – Papakura

NARRATIVE

The proposal attracted 387 submissions (plus 10 anonymous which cannot be considered by Council); and included a petition with 1591 signatories (a full copy is available in the Councillors Lounge).

32 submitters expressed a wish to be heard by Council. This Council meeting provides an opportunity for these submitters to support their views further via oral submission.

Deliberations on all submissions (both written and oral) will be undertaken at the next Council meeting on 27 July 2010.
